

CONSTITUTION (ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION)

ARTICLE 1: CREATION AND NAME

The Association is hereby created on the 17/02/2009 amongst the undersigned persons representing the founding members and those who will subsequently become members thereof.

This Association shall be governed by law N° 90/053 of 19/12/1990 and its Decree of implementation N° 92/455/PM of 23/11/1992.

The above Association shall be called **CENTER FOR ENVIRONMENT AND EDUCATION (CEE)**

It shall be abbreviated "CEE"

ARTICLE II

GOAL, OBJECTIVES AND AREA OF JURISDICTION

a) GOAL:

Protection of environment and the promotion of education for sustainable development.

b) OBJECTIVE:

1. Protection of natural resources
2. Integrate women and youths in the management of natural resources
3. Promote education at all levels for sustainable management of natural resources
4. Seeking for possibilities to provide rural and urban communities with basic needs like portable water, sanitation, food security and sustainable energy for poverty alleviation.

c) AREA OF JURISDICTION:

- The area of operation covers the national territory of Cameroon

ARTICLE III: HEAD OFFICE

The head office will be based in Ambam, South Region, Cameroon.

ARTICLE IV: FINANCIAL YEAR

The financial year shall commence on January 1st of each year and end on December 31st of each year. There will be stocktaking of its activities and financial obligations at the end of each year.

ARTICLE V: MEMBERSHIP

Membership is open to all Cameroonians and foreigners of both sexes. Each member is required to pay an approved registration fee non refundable adopted by the General Assembly and pledge to abide by the Association's rules and regulations.

ARTICLE VI: RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF MEMBERS

Any registered member shall have the right to:

- 1) Attend the General Meeting and participate in decision making;
- 2) Be elected to the management committee of the Association;
- 3) Abide to the rules and regulations governing the Association;
- 4) Consult the articles of the Association, internal regulations, register's minutes of the general meeting, reports, annual accounts and inventories and audit reports at the head office;
- 5) Withdraw from the association at any time subject to the provision of article 8;
- 6) The obligation to any statutory fines resulting from non-fulfilment of his/her commitments;
- 7) Member's liability over the indebtedness of the Association shall be twice their shares.

ARTICLE VII: CONDITIONS FOR WITHDRAWALS AND EXPULSIONS

- 1) A member may withdraw from the Association at-the-end of the financial year and have his/her registration fee not reimbursed.
- 2) Expulsion shall be available or re-appealed by the general meeting. Expulsion shall be decided by the Executive after a two-month notice which shall be written and specify the reasons for the expulsion.

ARTICLE VIII: FINES AND SANCTIONS

In case of non-compliance with the articles of the association and depending on the seriousness of the fault, the amount of the fine shall be fixed by the regulations or decided by the internal regulations or decided by the general meeting or members.

Sanctions to defaulters of the Association shall be decided by the General members of the Association, depending on the gravity of the offence.

ARTICLE IX: INTERNAL REGULATIONS

The internal regulations of the association shall give detail definition and explanation to the articles referred to above.

ARTICLE X: MODIFICATION OF THE ARTICLES OF THE ASSOCIATION


Any decision to modify these articles of the association shall be at the general assembly meeting by two third majorities of voters. The articles have been discussed by the management committee and accepted to be fitted in the agenda of the General Assembly.

ARTICLE XI: WITHDRAWAL OF MONEY FROM THE BANK

The withdrawal of money from the bank shall be done by at least two members of the executive and the delegate must be one of the signatories. This could be made up of delegate, secretary, financial secretary and treasurer. The visit to the bank will only be done when necessary.


